

GCA Facilities Receive Prestigious NACWA Awards for Stellar Permit Compliance



At its July 25, 2017 meeting, the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) recognized all five of Gulf Coast Authority's wastewater treatment facilities earning a combination of Platinum and Silver Peak Performance Awards for consistently outstanding work. The Platinum-6 Award represents 6 consecutive years of 100% compliance, and Silver Awards celebrate facilities for having no more than five violations within a calendar year.

GCA's 40-Acre Facility was awarded a Platinum6 Peak Performance Award in recognition of six years of complete and consistent National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit compliance.

GCA's Bayport, Odessa South, Washburn Tunnel, and Blackhawk Facilities were all awarded a Silver Peak Performance Awards in recognition of their collective consistent permit compliance during the calendar year 2016.

This year, a total of 471 NACWA Member Agencies in Texas had a total of 72 facilities earn Peak Performance recognition. This outstanding accomplishment signifies NACWA members' commitment to environmental protection and represents the diligence and hard work of each agency's employees.
